All shapes, designs and colours found within the memorials in this brochure can be manufactured in any material. Differing ornaments, frames and vases may also be added or replaced.

When choosing a memorial you should also take into consideration the durability of the stone. Granite is far more durable than marble and is ideally suited to the etching and sandblasting of detailed ornamentation. These ornamentations may be further personalised with mementoes, badges, or favourite scenes. Colour is used to further highlight the desired effect.

If you do not find exactly what you have in mind within our brochure, please visit our showroom – we have a large selection of memorials in stock, a further selection of booklets with differing designs and many years of experience in assisting personal and unique memorial design.

An application must be made on your behalf to the local authority or minister for permission to erect a memorial (or to inscribe an additional inscription) within a cemetery or churchyard. Diocese ruling for churchyard memorials outlines that only an unpolished stone and finish is allowed. White marble is not permitted within a churchyard.

Lettering on a granite stone may be either gilded or coloured. Traditional lead lettering is a far more durable finish when choosing a marble headstone. Please remember that both granite and marble, as with all the best natural materials, will differ slightly in shade and colouring. This brochure shows an average selection.
